PROPOSED STATEMENT REGARDING AFFORDABLE AND ABUNDANT TRANSPORTATION FOR STUDENTS

WHEREAS,

Facing the surge of rental rates within Westwood, West Los Angeles, and the Greater Los Angeles Area, an increasing number of Westwood students face relying on public transportation for getting to and from their domiciles and educational institutions. Transportation for students is a CITY WIDE issue.

NOW THEREFORE,

The Westwood Neighborhood Council requests Mayor Eric Garcetti, Councilmember Paul Koretz, UCLA Transportation, the City of Culver City and METRO Board to provide affordable student rates for METRO, Bruin Bus, and Green Bus Line transportation lines as well as provide more-frequent stops within the North Village of Westwood and other areas where students reside like Palms, Playa Del Rey, the San Fernando Valley, East Los Angeles, South Central, and Mid-Wilshire.
